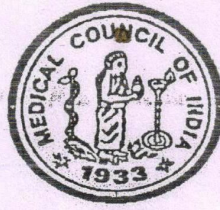

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to convey the approval of Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India for renewal of permission for admission of 4th batch of 150 (one hundred fifty only) MBBS students at Saraswati Medical College, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic Year 2019-2020. The Board of Governors has granted approval after consideration of the compliance submitted by the college authorities vide letter dated 05.03.2019 in respect of deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report (3rd & 4th January, 2019) alongwith the summary/observations of the member of the Undergraduate Expert Group appointed by the Board of Governors.

2. The Permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of 150 students during the academic year 2019-2020. The next batch of students in MBBS course will be admitted in the college only after permission of Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI for renewal/recognition.

3. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made there under.

4. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI and the State Govt.

The Board of Governors have also directed that the college authorities will submit an undertaking that they have corrected the deficiencies as mentioned in the compliance submitted by the college authorities.
